The practical matters – the way of doing something

A family matter – an issue concerned with the matter

An economic matter – a money issue

An environmental matter – a problem with the environment

Bring up/broach/raise a matter – raise an issue

Drop the matter – leave the matter

Settle/solve a matter – find a solution

Address/handle/treat/deal with a matter – tackle a problem

Consider/think about/examine/investigate a matter – research an issue

Press/pursue a matter – try to find out about something

Be no laughing matter – not be funny or a joke

The matter in hand – the important part of something

Let the matter go – forget about something
