Auxiliary verbs are an essential part of English grammar and are needed to form both negative and interrogative sentences. Auxiliary verbs are in effect, the most basic part of the English language and should be practiced right from the start when language learners and picking up the basics:

The most basic auxiliaries are:

Be

You are happy. Are you happy?

It is interesting. Is it interesting?

Have

He has gone out. Has he gone out?

Do

I do not enjoy going on holiday with my family. Do you enjoy going on holiday with your family?

You must also review modal verbs, as they are also used as auxiliaries:

Will, would, should, might, can, could, must
