REFLEXIVE PRONOUNS

I	MYSELF
YOU	YOURSELF
HE	HIMSELF
SHE	HERSELF
IT	ITSELF
THEY	THEMSELVES
WE	OURSELVES
YOU (PLURAL)	YOURSELVES

When do you use reflexive pronouns:

We use reflexive pronouns when we have a subject and an object in a sentence and they are the same thing. For instance:

*I am looking at **myself** in the mirror.*

*I have been talking to **myself** all day.*

***You** are listening to **yourself** in a recording.*

***We** are watching **ourselves** on TV.*

Not: I am talking to me.

We also use reflexive pronouns to emphasize the fact that someone needs to do something alone; we normally do this by using the imperative.

Do it **yourself** = You must do it alone.

*Clean it **yourself*** = You have to clean it by yourself.
