

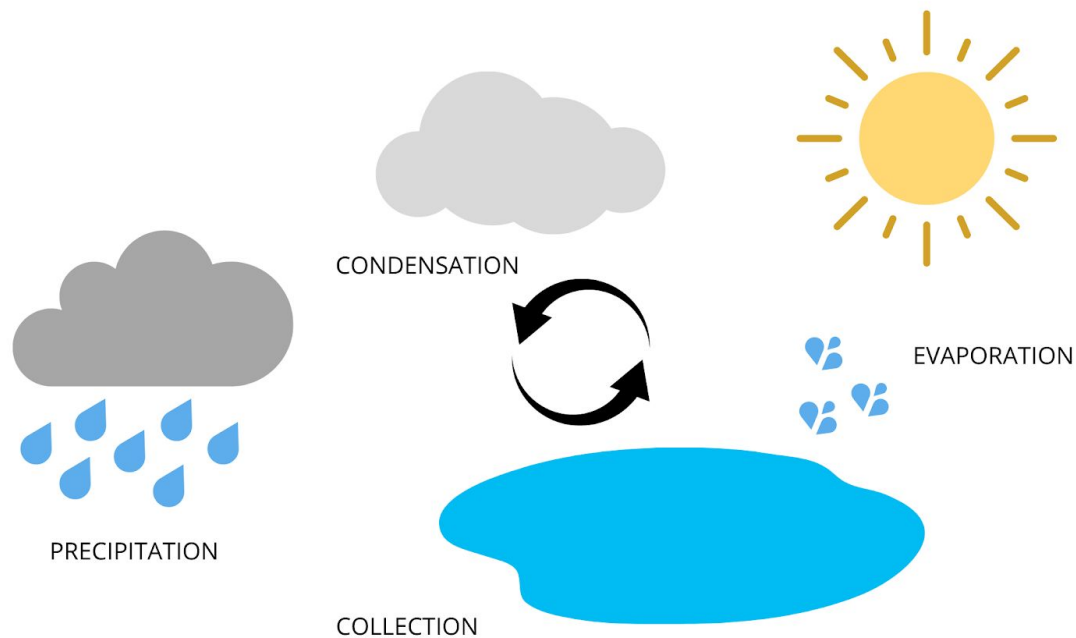

The Water Cycle



Water is always changing state, from solid to liquid to gas. The process is called the water cycle. First the water evaporates, this is called evaporation. Next it forms clouds, this is called condensation. Then the water falls, this is called precipitation. Finally, water flows into rivers and oceans, this is called precolation or collection.

Put the water cycle in order:

- Condensation. Water vapour forms clouds.
- Evaporation. Water evaporates into the air.
- Precipitation. Water falls down.
- Collection. Water flows into rivers, lakes and oceans.
