ING VERBS: WE USE ING VERBS IN THE PRESENT CONTINUOUS:
SUBJECT + TO BE + ING VERBS

NORMAL VERBS + ING (SING, WALK, FLY, GO, DO, LISTEN, DRAW)
ALSO WHEN THERE ARE TWO VOWELS (EAT) OR A Y/W (PLAY/DRAW)

❑ WALK + ING = TALKING

VERBS THAT END IN E (HAVE, LIVE, DRIVE, SMILE, MAKE, USE, TAKE)
DELETE THE E + ING

❑ WRITE + ING = WRITING

SHORT VERBS: (RUN, PUT, GET, SIT, STOP, CLAP, PLAN)
1 VOWEL + 1 CONSONANT = DOUBLE THE CONSONANT

❑ SWIM + ING = SWIMING
