



## LET'S LEARN ABOUT SCHOOL IN THE 3<sup>o</sup> PERSON

SUBJECT	VERB	EXAMPLE SENTENCE
HE	WRITES	<i>He always <u>writes</u> in his notebook.</i>
SHE	DOES	<i>She usually <u>does</u> her homework.</i>

When we use the 3<sup>o</sup> person (HE/SHE) we add **S** or **ES**: Do = **does**

Write = **writes**

Listen = **listens**

Play = **plays**

Read = **reads**

Draw = **draws**

Use = **uses**

Cut = **cuts**

Sing = **sings**

Stick = **sticks**
